**RIVERSIDE/CORONA DISTRICT
 ACREAGE AND AGRICULTURAL CROP REPORT
 2006**

Riverside County's total gross valuation for 2006 is \$ 1,102,438,400.

Riverside County's total agricultural production is derived from four separate and distinct districts: Riverside/Corona, San Jacinto/Temecula Valley, Coachella Valley, and the Palo Verde Valley.

Below is a table comparing the value of the agricultural crops in each of the districts during the last three years.
