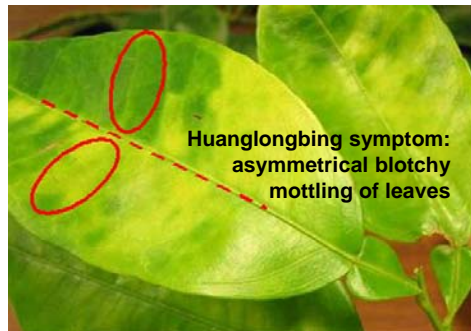


Asian Citrus Psyllid

Diaphorina citri is an insect vector of Huanglongbing disease of citrus. Psyllid feeding damage includes twisting and burned tips of new flush.

Huanglongbing or citrus greening disease is caused by a bacterium. Symptoms of the disease include leaf mottling, yellow shoots, twig dieback and small hard fruit with a bitter taste. The disease is spread by the psyllid or by grafting infected budwood.
