**SAN JACINTO/TEMECULA VALLEY
ACREAGE AND AGRICULTURAL CROP REPORT
2003**

Riverside County had a gross valuation of \$ 1,067,367,300.

Riverside County's agricultural production is derived from four districts - Riverside/Corona, San Jacinto/Temecula Valley, Coachella Valley, and Palo Verde Valley.

Below is a table comparing the value of the agricultural crops in each of the districts for the last three years.
